Orff Schulwerk Level I

WHAT:

Foundations and principles of the Orff Schulwerk approach for teaching music to children will be presented in an intensive training through theory and practice. The Orff approach begins with experience in speech and movement and uses singing, playing instruments, improvisation, composition and understanding notation as tools for developing musicianship.

The training program is designed to accommodate music specialists, classroom teachers with music background, church musicians and other educators whose interests lie primarily in the interactive learning of music. An ability to read and write music is essential.

Course work includes basic philosophy and pedagogical principles of Orff Schulwerk, instruction and pedagogy in recorder, basic movement skills and their applications, technical skill development with untuned and tuned percussion instruments, sequential approach to song material and improvisation, pedagogical models for effective teaching. This course is designed to meet the basic criteria for certification by the American Orff-Schulwerk Association (AOSA).
